All submissions should be original, previously unpublished works in English. Feature articles should range from 5,000 to 7,500 words; book reviews, from 750 to 1,000 words. To facilitate the blind-review process do not include your name or institutional affiliation in the article itself. The editorial style of the JGI is the APA Style.
