INTERLIBRARY LOAN

While GIL Express is great for getting books from other schools in the university system, **Interlibrary Loan** is a wonderful service for accessing articles and less common books from all over the world.

If you find that Sturgis Library does not have access to an article or a book you need, simply fill out a request form with as much information as you can and the ILL department will try to get the material you need as soon as possible. Articles can arrive in as little as a few days, while books usually arrive in less than two weeks.
