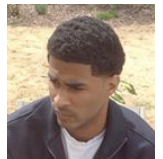

*Spotlight - Student Assistant of the Month April - Jonathan Conwell*



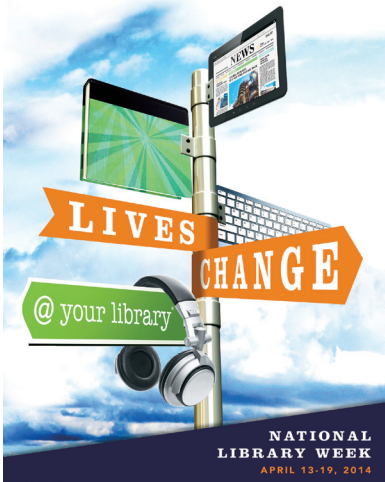
