## **Reference Updates**

New reference procedures at Johnson will start January 6th.

#### LibWizard v2 is here!

We migrated to the most recent version of LibWizard on December 16 without a hitch. There are a number of improvements, but these new features are particularly exciting:

- Tutorials can now be set up to generate a certificate of completion
  - Editing workspace in tutorials has been cleaned up, including an option to minimize slide content while making other edits
    - Improved accessibility
- More permissions for staff accounts, including adding editors to learning objects and transferring ownership
