# biographies

**A**lison Mann is Associate Professor of Choral Music Education and Program Coordinator for Music Education at Kennesaw State University, where she teaches coursework in Choral Methods, Foundations of Music Education and Vocal Pedagogy for Ensemble Singing. Mann also supervises student teachers and serves as Conductor of the KSU Women's Choir and University Chorale.

A native of Florida, Mann taught in the Orlando public schools as Director of Choral Activities at William R. Boone High School and was also the Assistant Conductor of the Orlando Chorale. While in Orlando, choirs and soloists under her direction received top honors at the district and state levels.

Dr. Mann received her Ph.D. in Music Education and Choral Conducting from the University of Oregon, and a Masters of Choral Music Education and Bachelors of Choral Music Education from Florida State University. Dr. Mann has studied conducting and music education with André Thomas, Kevin Fenton, Sharon J. Paul, Judy Bowers and Harry Price. Dr. Mann is currently the Southern Division ACDA Women's Choir Repertoire and Standards Chair, and the Georgia state ACDA Membership Chair. Mann has also served as the ACDA Multicultural and Ethics Repertoire and Standards Chair for the states of Georgia and Oregon and the Georgia Women's Choir Repertoire and Standards Chair.

The Women's Choir has performed on numerous occasions with the KSU Symphony Orchestra, and performed the world premiere of Nico Muhly's composition, *How Soon*, with Grammy award-winning ensemble, eighth blackbird. Additionally, they were invited to sing at the GMEA 2014 In-Service Conference in Savannah. Her professional affiliations include the American Choral Directors Association, National Association for Music Education, Georgia Music Educators Association, National Collegiate Choral Organization, and the International Society for Music Education. Her research has been presented at the state, regional, and international levels. Dr. Mann is an active conductor, clinician, and adjudicator.

**A**lexis Lundy, a native of Locust Grove, Georgia, teaches music at the Lower School of Holy Innocents' Episcopal School. As Lower School music teacher, she directs the 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade choruses, directs the music for the annual 5th grade musical, and leads the Praise Team for

Chapel Services. She is a graduate of the Indiana University Jacobs School of Music where she received her Master of Music degree in voice performance. She graduated cum laude with honors in music from Shorter College in Rome, GA, where she earned bachelor degrees in voice performance and music education. Ms Lundy currently serves as co-director of the Georgia District Metropolitan Opera National Council Auditions. She is a staff singer at Glenn Memorial United Methodist Church where she also directs their Covenant Choir. Ms. Lundy is a member of the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra Chorus and Chamber Chorus as well as the chamber choir Coro Vocati. Her professional affiliations include the American Choral Directors Association, National Association for Music Education, Georgia Music Educators Association, Kodály Educators of Georgia, and the Organization of American Kodály Educators.

**M**egan Otte, a native of Texas, teaches music at King Springs Elementary School in Smyrna, Georgia. As the Music Specialist, she teaches music to children ages four to eleven, directs the annual musical programs for kindergarten, first, third and fifth grades, leads the Melody Makers after-school chorus and participates in community outreach through performances with Melody Makers. Ms. Otte also teaches private lessons in voice and piano to students in the Atlanta area. She is a graduate of Florida State University where she received her Masters of Choral Music Education. She graduated magna cum laude from Kennesaw State University where she earned her Bachelors of Music Education and was awarded the titles of University Scholar and Outstanding Senior. Ms. Otte has studied conducting and music education with Andre Thomas, Kevin Fenton, Alison Mann, and Judy Bowers. She is a staff singer at Peachtree Road United Methodist Church and is a member of the chamber choir Coro Vocati. Her professional affiliations include the American Choral Directors Association, National Association for Music Education, Georgia Music Educators Association, and the Music Honor Society Pi Kappa Lambda.

**C**hristian Artieda was born in Quito, Ecuador, and is currently an Atlanta-based musician, composer, and educator who is committed to providing the best possible experience to his audience and students. Mr. Artieda is currently majoring in Music Education with a concentration in Jazz Guitar, studying under Trey Wright. He is also enrolled in the Joel A. Katz Music and Entertainment Business program at Kennesaw State University. Since January of 2014, Mr. Artieda works as the Academic Dean at the Canzion Institute of Atlanta, where he also teaches music theory and ear training.
